- Cohort start is based on administrative approval, funding, and a minimum number of qualified applicants. Planned start date January 6, 2025
- Application fee: \$60
 - There is a mandatory Orientation near the beginning of the first semester.
- Hybrid/Online model of delivery for lab skills/theory/didactic courses.
- Labs in semesters 3 and 4: These are 9-10 hour full campus days (8a-6p) during those two semesters at the-
