Please note that the AS (RN) program now offers Hybrid-Online option and plans to do so every semester thereafter. After one gains admissions to the nursing program admitted students will be able to select WSU Ogden, WSU Davis (Layton) or the Hybrid-Online option. It will be on a first come first serve basis so once a student receives their acceptance materials they need to respond ASAP. The WSU/Ogden and WSU/Davis locations function the following way: Two days a week (Monday through Friday) students will be committed to a nursing class day (1 day) and a lab, clinical or clinical simulation day (1 day) for the first THREE semesters of the 4 semester program. Then in the final FOURTH semester the class day moves to online delivery and students complete a capstone - rather than lab, clinical or clinical simulation.
