Glen David Gold (born 1964) is an American author, known as the writer of <u>Carter Beats the Devil</u> and <u>Sunnyside</u>. Carter Beats the Devil is a fictionalized biography of <u>Charles Joseph Carter</u> (1874–1936), an American illusionist performing from c. 1900 to 1936. His second novel, <u>Sunnyside</u>, was published in 2009. Short stories of his—including "The Tears of <u>Squonk</u>"—have appeared in a number of issues of <u>McSweeney's</u>.

Gold received his BA from <u>Wesleyan University</u> and his MFA in creative writing at the <u>University of California at Irvine</u>.
